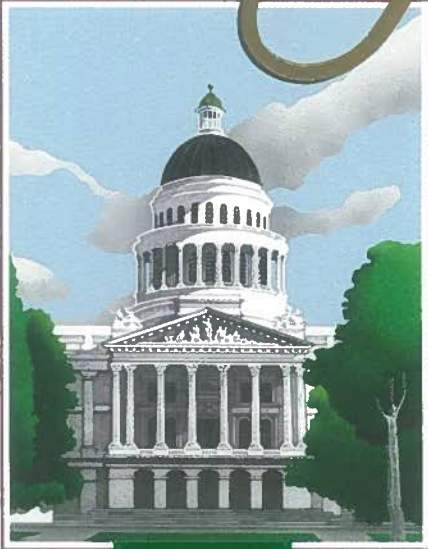

Whereas, For 30 years, the Golden Eagle District of the Boy Scouts of America, San Gabriel Valley Council, has provided boys and young men the opportunity to join together for companionship, community service, and participation in constructive and worthwhile group activities; and

Whereas, As a committed local affiliate of the Boy Scouts of America, the Golden Eagle District endeavors to develop American citizens who are physically, mentally, and emotionally fit; have a high degree of self-reliance as evidenced in such qualities as initiative, courage, and resourcefulness; have the desire and skills to help others; understand the principles of the American social, economic, and governmental systems; take pride in their American heritage and understand our nation's role in the world; have a keen respect for the basic rights of all people; and are prepared to participate in and give leadership to American society; and

Whereas, Located in the southeastern region of the San Gabriel Valley, the Golden Eagle District encompasses scouting communities in the cities of Pomona, Walnut, Diamond Bar, Rowland Heights, Valinda, City of Industry, Hacienda Heights, West Covina, and La Puente; and

Whereas, The Golden Eagle District traces its origins to 1939, when the Rancho District was created after the San Gabriel Valley Council was divided into three districts; originally named for Rancho La Puente, the District was renamed multiple times, becoming Lucky Baldwin, Lucky Trails, Los Conquistadors, Chaparral, Conquistadors, and ultimately Mountain View prior to 1984, when, as the largest district in the council, it was divided at the San Bernardino Freeway, with the territory south of the freeway becoming the Golden Eagle District; and


Whereas, In the year 2014, 47 young men from the Golden Eagle District achieved the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout, contributing over 6,000 hours of community service through their Eagle projects; and

Whereas, Through scouting, young boys establish strong bonds of friendship and obtain a sense of "family" from within the group, and the boys have an opportunity to gain experiences and knowledge that may not otherwise be available to them; now, therefore, be it
